The C-130H has been a Herculean workhorse for the Air Force since it was first obtained in the mid-1970s.

Airmen from the 314th Airlift Wing at Little Rock Air Force Base have been training aircrews and maintenance on the basics of the C-130H airframe for more than a decade.

Air Force active-duty squadrons are transitioning from the older H-model aircraft to the newer J-model in the coming years. The 314th AW will focus on J-model training and the Arkansas Air National Guard will fully take over all future training of H-model students in less than three months.

The C-130J Super Hercules offers a variety of benefits over the legacy H-model. C-130Js fly faster, can carry more cargo, travel further and require a minimum crew of three instead of five due

to advanced computer technology.

Recently, the final H-model training flight for the 314th AW took flight. The mission involved maintenance students who were taught by active-duty instructors from the 314th Aircraft Maintenance Squadron.

Training for H-model pilots and loadmasters has already transitioned to Arkansas ANG Airmen and maintenance training is the last to be handed over completely.

Though the J-model is more advanced and has improved capabilities, some Airmen have mixed feelings about the transition.

“I grew up on the older H-models,” said Staff Sgt. Daniel Elmore, a 314th Aircraft Maintenance Squadron C-130H dedicated crew chief. “It’s a sad day for me; the maintenance for these planes is more hands-on and these Hercs have more character.”

The remainder of active-duty

314th AMXS C-130H instructors will re-train to the C-130J, after training for Arkansas ANG members is complete.

“I’ll miss the old-school legacy models,” said Staff Sgt. Jason Manning, a 314th AMXS dedicated crew chief. “We now need to learn a whole new system, though it won’t be the first time transitioning to a

new aircraft for most of us.”

Airmen from the 314th AMXS started advising Arkansas ANG instructors on H-model operations in October 2014 and will continue to do so for approximately another year.

“This is a great step for the Guard,” said Staff Sgt. David




The meeting with unit representatives is scheduled for 8 to 9:30 a.m. at Hangar 1080. During the briefing, EES/WAPS subject matter experts will speak about changes that have already been implemented, those slated for implementation in the months ahead, and the reasons and philosophy behind the changes.

“This is one of the most significant changes to the enlisted evaluation and promotion

system in a generation. So, we feel it’s important to bring this information directly to Commanders and Airmen and allow them to ask questions and get immediate answers from the experts,” said Maj. Gen. Peggy Poore, AFPC commander.”



Service star authorized on GWOT Expeditionary Medal

JOINT BASE SAN ANTONIO-RANDOLPH, Texas – Active duty, Air National Guard and Air Force Reserve Airmen who earned the Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary Medal for more than one of the five Department of Defense approved GWOT-EM operations may now wear a service star device on the medal and service ribbon for the second and subsequent awards, Air Force officials said.

The policy is retroactive to Sept. 11, 2001, and covers the following approved operations and inclusive dates:

■ Operation Enduring Freedom, Sept. 11, 2001-date to be determined

■ Operation Iraqi Freedom, March 19, 2003-Aug. 31, 2010

■ Operation Nomad Shadow, Nov. 5, 2007-date to be determined

■ Operation New Dawn, Sept. 1, 2010-Dec. 31, 2011

■ Operation Inherent Resolve, June 15, 2014-date to be determined

For example, an Airman awarded the GWOT Expeditionary Medal for an Operation Enduring Freedom deployment and a second medal for an Operation Inherent Resolve deployment would wear the medal or service ribbon with one service star device.

Although the policy is retroactive, conversions are not authorized. Airmen who initially earned the GWOT-EM and elected to accept the Iraqi Campaign, Afghanistan Campaign or Air Force Expeditionary Medal instead cannot convert back to the GWOT-EM and add a service star for

subsequent awards.

Airmen awarded the GWOT-EM who have completed a subsequent deployment to a qualifying area/operation should take supporting documents to their local military personnel section to have their records updated to reflect the award of a service star to their GWOT-EM. Supporting documents include contingency exercise deployment orders or completed paid travel vouchers, or decoration citations which indicate the deployment dates, deployment area and/or name of the operation.

Summer safety begins with risk management

KIRTLAND AIR FORCE BASE, N.M. (AFNS) –

Increased travel and leisure activities go hand in hand with the summer months, and require increased emphasis on risk management, said Bill Parsons, the Air Force chief of ground safety

While Airmen and their families make the most of recreational opportunities during the summer, the period between Memorial Day and Labor Day weekends is the most important time to incorporate risk management in off-duty leisure activities. This is accomplished by using the same safety processes as those used on duty, Parsons said.

“Unfortunately, that same period ended last

year with 17 fatalities,” Parsons said. “We need every Airman to commit to making that number zero this year, and we do that by using the same risk management skills we apply on the job to ensure everyone returns safely at summer’s end and ready to accomplish the

mission. Summer safety is the extension of our ‘Quest for Zero’ mishaps.”

Whether traveling, participating in water activities, sporting events or cookouts, Airmen should identify, assess and mitigate all risks to include: trip planning that ensures enough rest and preparation for contingencies, no alcohol while driving or participating in recreational activities, and use of appropriate protective gear in all activities.

“Most mishaps are preventable,” Parsons said, “and mishap prevention requires doing the right thing. Sometimes the right thing is as simple as stepping up and stepping in when we see something that doesn’t look right. That alone can avert a potential disaster.”

Rogers, a 189th Arkansas ANG crew chief. “It means bigger responsibility and a larger footprint for us.”

The 189th Airlift Wing has the largest C-130H fleet in the Air Force. Ongoing upgrades to the C-130H will add an additional 40,000 hours of flying time to the plane. The unit will have more than 20 of the legacy models and various ANG and Reserve units across the country will receive additional H-models.

While the book has closed on active-duty training of the legacy C-130s, the next chapter in the long history of C-130H instruction at Little Rock Air Force Base continues with the help of Airmen from the Arkansas ANG.







LRAFB HISTORY FAST FACT

90 DAYS TO GO UNTIL LRAFB TURNS 60!

On July 1, 1986, the Arkansas Air National Guard received its first C-130E. The arrival of the "Herc" signified the beginning of a mission change from KC-135 in-flight refueling to training C-130 aircrews. In the mid-1980s, the Air Staff decided to involve Air National Guard units in flight training due to Air National Guard and Reserve units possessing more than half of all Air Force airlift aircraft. Within three months of the conversion, the 154th Tactical Airlift Training Squadron began C-130 Phase I initial flight crew training. Since 1998, the 189th Airlift Wing has been home to the only schoolhouse for C-130 aircrews to become instructor pilots in their respective crew positions. Today, the 189th conducts entry-level loadmaster and flight engineer training while also providing initial and instructor aircrew qualification training for the Department of Defense and more than 20 allied nations.

Did you know, in the state of Arkansas, you can file for divorce “pro se” – basically meaning “do-it-yourself?” Though it is still advised that you seek the advice of a legal

assistance attorney or civilian family law attorney, a pro se divorce is usually simpler and much less expensive.

Though our legal assistance attorneys cannot go to court for you, they can still advise you about the issues and procedures in your case and the laws of the state in which you reside.


