IMPROVED SECURITY FOR DRIVERS' LICENSES AND PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION CARDS

Secure driver's licenses and identification documents are a vital component of our national security framework. The REAL ID Act, passed by Congress in 2005, enacted the 9/11 Commission's recommendation that the Federal Government "set standards for the issuance of sources of identification, such as driver's licenses." The Act established minimum security standards for license issuance and production and prohibits Federal agencies from accepting for certain purposes driver's licenses and identification cards from states not meeting the Act's minimum standards. **The purposes covered by the Act are: accessing Federal facilities, entering nuclear power plants, and, no sooner than 2016, boarding federally regulated commercial aircraft.**

This pamphlet lists states not in compliance, states in compliance, and states who have approved extensions for implementation and the required implementation dates. It also lists acceptable forms of identification if you do not have an Enhanced Drivers License from your state.

Identification (including driver's licenses) from States failing to comply with the REAL ID act will no longer be accepted for official purposes based on Phase 3b of the Real ID Act being implemented 15 Aug 16, would restrict the use of identification from non-compliant states when attempting to access military facilities.

The following states/territories are NOT compliant with the REAL ID Act. At midnight on 15 Aug 2016, Little Rock AFB will no longer accept licenses from these states unless it is an Enhanced Driver's License:

The following states/territories are compliant with the REAL ID Act and driver's licenses will be accepted for access to Little Rock AFB:

The following states/territories have an extension, allowing Federal agencies to accept driver's licenses from these states until October 10, 2016. At midnight on 10 Oct 2016, Little Rock AFB will no longer accept licenses from these states unless it is an Enhanced Driver's License:

Below are acceptable forms of identification for identity proofing for access to Little Rock AFB if you do not have an Enhanced Driver's License:

- United States Passport, not expired
- Original or Certified copy of a birth certificate
- Consular Report of Birth Abroad
- Certificate of Naturalization issued by DHS
- Certificate of Citizenship
- Permanent Resident Card/Alien Registration Receipt Card (Form I-551)
- A foreign passport with a temporary (I-551) stamp or temporary (I-551) printed notation on a machine readable immigrant visa
- An employment authorization document that contains a photograph (Form I-766)
- Identification card issued by Federal, State, or local government agencies, provided it contains a photograph and biographic information such as name, date of birth, gender, height, eye color, and address
- U.S. Coast Guard Merchant Mariner Cards/Credentials
- U.S. Certificate of Naturalization or Certificate of Citizenship (Form N-550) and U.S. Permanent Resident Card (Form I-551)
- U.S. Refugee travel document or other travel document or evidence of immigration status issued by DHS containing a photograph
- A Foreign Government Issued Passport
