SUBJECT: AMC Pass Day Policy for Calendar Year 2026

1. In recognition of our team's exceptional service, I am declaring the following dates as AMC Pass Days for calendar year 2026:

AMC Pass Day	In Conjunction With
2 January (Friday)	New Year's Day - 1 Jan (Thursday)
13 February (Friday)	Presidents' Day – 16 Feb (Monday)
22 May (Friday)	Memorial Day – 25 May (Monday)
2 July (Thursday)	Independence Day – 3 Jul (Friday)
4 September (Friday)	Labor Day – 7 Sep (Monday)
12 November (Thursday)	Veteran's Day – 11 Nov (Wednesday)
27 November (Friday)	Thanksgiving Day – 26 Nov (Thursday)
24 December (Thursday)	Christmas Day – 25 Dec (Friday)
31 December (Thursday)	New Year's Day – 1 Jan 27 (Friday)

2. Commanders retain the authority to approve liberal leave or pass days, prioritizing mission requirements and unit readiness. Subordinate commanders may adjust or deny these opportunities based on local operational demands and alignment with readiness objectives.
3. For our civilian teammates, supervisors should encourage the use of accrued leave, comp time, or time-off awards in accordance with DoDI 1400.25V630 and DAFI 36-1004. Group time-off awards used solely to create a day off remain prohibited.
4. I trust AMC leaders to apply this guidance with the professionalism and care that define our command. By maintaining readiness while giving space for recovery and recognition, we continue to prove that Air Mobility Command delivers—anytime, anywhere.
