## See Something, Say Something

Our safety and security rely on the vigilance of every community member. If you see suspicious activity, don't hesitate to report it. Your observation, no matter how small it may seem, could be the key to preventing a crime or even saving lives.

#### What is Suspicious Activity?

Suspicious activity is anything that seems out of place, unusual, or doesn't belong. It could be:

- Unusual behavior or activity by individuals or groups
- Unattended packages or bags left in public places
- Vehicles parked in unusual locations or for extended periods
- Someone showing unusual interest in secure areas
- Attempts to gain unauthorized access to restricted areas

Don't hesitate! If you see something suspicious, say something!

### When reporting, remember the SALUTE format:

- Size: How many people were involved?
- Activity: What were they doing? Be specific.
- Location: Where did you observe the activity? Provide a precise address or landmark if possible.
- Uniform (Clothing/Description): What were they wearing? Provide as much detail as possible about their appearance.
- Time: When did you observe the activity? Be as specific as possible with the time and date.
- Equipment: Did they have any equipment with them? (e.g., backpacks, bags, tools)

#### **Example SALUTE Report:**

"I saw two (Size) individuals loitering (Activity) near the back entrance of the library (Location). They were wearing dark hoodies and jeans (Uniform). I saw them around 3:00 PM today (Time). One of them had a large backpack (Equipment)."

#### **Why Report?**

- Prevent Crime: Reporting suspicious activity can help law enforcement prevent crimes before they occur.
- Save Lives: Your observation could be crucial in preventing acts of violence or terrorism.
- Protect Your Community: By reporting suspicious activity, you contribute to the safety and security of your community.

#### Remember:

- Stay Safe: Do not confront suspicious individuals.
- Be Observant: Pay attention to your surroundings.
- Trust Your Instincts: If something doesn't feel right, it probably isn't.
