Disabled Veteran Leave Request

Applicable to: Civilian

Established under the Wounded Warriors Federal Leave Act of 2015 (Wounded Warriors Act), disabled veteran leave will be available to any Federal employee hired on or after 5 November 2016, who is a veteran with a service-connected disability rating of 30 percent or more.

Provide your letter from the Veteran Benefits Administration (VBA) which certifies you have a qualifying service connected disability. This document **must** include the effective date of the qualifying disability as determined by the VBA

Submit your letter using the Disabled Veteran Leave (DVL) Request Form.
