AF leaders cheer on Airmen at Warrior Games

WASHINGTON – Air Force senior leaders attended the 2017 Warrior Games opening ceremonies July 1 in Chicago to show support for the athletes participating in the weeklong competition.

While there, Secretary of the Air Force Heather Wilson, Air Force Chief of Staff Gen. David L. Goldfein, and Chief Master Sgt. of the Air Force Kaleth O. Wright attended several events in addition to the opening ceremonies, including pistol and rifle shooting, sitting volleyball and wheelchair basketball.

During the games Airmen will also compete in archery, swimming, track and field, and cycling.

“The Warrior Games showcase the competitive spirit of our wounded warriors,” said Wilson. “Athletic competition at this level requires focused hard work of body, mind and spirit.”

The goal of the Warrior Games is to use sports to inspire recovery, support rehabilitation and generate a wider understanding and respect of those who serve.

“These athletes have risked it all for their country,” Goldfein said. “Competing in the Warrior Games is a testament to not only the hard work they’ve put in, but also to the family members and close friends who have made their own sacrifices to help them get here.”

WARRIOR CARE

Air Force leadership has made taking care of Airmen a priority through initiatives like the Air Force Wounded Warrior program, which works to ensure wounded warriors receive personalized support and care from the point of injury or illness, through return to duty, separation, or retirement, but acknowledge there is still work to be done.

“We take an aircraft off the line at a certain point for scheduled maintenance,” Goldfein said. “We pull panels, make sure everything is good, get it back on the line, and later we take a deeper look with depot maintenance. We do this for our aircraft, but what would it look like if we did this for our people?”

Goldfein said the Air Force is working to build a program similar to Special Operations Command’s Preservation of the Force and Family initiative. POTFF looks at how Airmen are doing physically, mentally,

emotionally and spiritually on a regular, reoccurring basis, and makes sure they’re getting the type of support they need.

“The ultimate source of our capability as a service resides in the men and women of the Air Force,” Wright said. “We must put them first.”

Wilson agrees, adding that it’s important for the Air Force to maintain its wingman culture.

“We have to take care of each other, identify problems, and get Airmen help when it’s needed,” she said.



A LITTLE ABOUT ME

Caswell joined the Air Force in 2001 as a Aerospace Maintenance Craftsman, working on heavy aircraft such as the C-5, C-17 and C-130. His career took him to RAF Lakenheath, United Kingdom, where he was involved in intramural rugby. During a match in 2010 he suffered a fractured leg from a dirty hit, an injury that required multiple surgeries, eventually leading to a below-the-knee amputation right leg. Jason fought hard to return to full duty status following his injury, which would allow him to deploy. He deployed to Afghanistan in support of Operations Freedom's Sentinel and Resolute Support he was responsible for aircrew briefings and supporting the movement of over 34,400 passengers and 27,100 tons of cargo. Three weeks after returning from his deployment he competed at the 2017 Air Force Trials, earning a position on the team as the co-captain for a second time. He said this opportunity, "Means everything to me. I get to show people that life is not over because you are hurt. I truly never thought I could get back to where I am at now, but I did, and it is time for me to show what I really can do." Sgt. Caswell has a long-term goal of retiring from the military, with a short-term goal of making master sergeant—a goal he found out he met with the E-8 promotion results.



AADD: Ensuring Airmen arrive alive

Airmen are encouraged to think ahead to safely arrive home after a night of drinking. If those plans fall through, Airmen Against Drunk Driving is there to help.

AADD is a group of volunteers at Little Rock Air Force Base who provide rides home to service members, dependents and civilian employees who have been drinking – no questions asked.

“We aren’t here to get you in trouble,” said Airman 1st Class Cooper Graham, AADD vice president and 19th Communications Squadron client systems technician. “We just want to get you home safely.”

AADD’s mission is for every Airman to get home incident free every night, even when their plans don’t work out. If arrangements with designated drivers or

friends fail, AADD volunteers can prevent the temptation of driving home under the influence of alcohol.

The service is anonymous, and the dispatcher and drivers don’t ask questions or keep a record of calls; the purpose of AADD is protecting the individuals of Little Rock AFB, not to get them in trouble.

“Everyone who puts their life on the line for our country deserves to be taken care of,” said Airman 1st Class Wyatt Lynch, AADD president and 19th Communications Squadron client systems technician. “We will pick you up, take you home and make sure you’re safe.”

Anyone assigned to Little Rock AFB can assist with AADD and serve as dispatchers, standby drivers, schedulers and advertising and recruitment coordinators.
