# DoD personnel assist in Thai cave rescue operations

WASHINGTON – Defense Department personnel assisted in the rescue operations in Thailand to evacuate 12 boys and their soccer coach from a flooded cave system, said the director of defense press operations.

The DoD effort consists of 42 deployed military personnel and one member from the Joint U.S. Military Advisory Group Thailand, Army Col. Rob Manning told reporters at the Pentagon.

“Coordination and interaction with Thai military, Thai government, and other multinational civilians and government

“We continue to fully support the multinational rescue effort and pray for the safe return of the remaining members of the team,” Manning said.

The soccer team and their coach entered the Tham Luang cave in Chiang Rai province in northern Thailand on June 23 and were trapped by floodwaters for 18 days. The final four boys and their coach were rescued June 10.

Manning paid tribute to former Thai Navy SEAL Saman Kunan, who died after delivering oxygen tanks in the cave.

“The death of the former Thai Navy SEAL illustrates the difficulty of this rescue,” Manning said. “His sacrifice will not be forgotten.”

# Team Little Rock hosts panel to celebrate pride month history

Little Rock Air Force Base Airmen celebrated and discussed the history of Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual and Transgender Pride Month with an informative question-and-answer panel June 26 at Little Rock Air Force Base.

“Events like this are just a small part of the greater discussion that happens during LGBT pride month,” said Capt. Beau Downey, an LGBT Panel attendee. “Hearing Airmen tell their personal experiences is key because real understanding comes from the day-to-day interactions with Airmen who are members of the LGBT community.”

Base leadership and numerous speakers who are part of, or have been affected by, the LGBT community spoke on the history and personal events which transformed them as Airmen as well as

their support for the community as part of this year’s theme: “Remember the Past, Create the Future.”

Just 40 years after President Harry S. Truman signed the Uniform Code of Military Justice establishing rules for discharging homosexual service members, President Bill Clinton introduced the “Don’t Ask, Don’t Tell” compromise for lifting the ban on homosexual service members in 1993.

The new compromise mandates that individuals seeking military service shouldn’t be asked about their sexual orientation. This policy lasted until 2010.

“The military is the best example you’ll ever find of inclusiveness,” said Lewis Vance, 19th Force Support Squadron deputy director. “Our leaders do not separate or discriminate against the people who make up our service.”

Finally in 2015, a long battle in the LGBT community was won when the U.S. Supreme Court ruled same-sex marriage as a legal right across the United States.

Today, because of these rights, Airmen can openly discuss and educate their brothers and sisters-in-arms on the struggles of a community that was once neglected and ignored.



## Reserve C-130s support Colorado firefighting efforts

PETERSON AIR FORCE BASE, Colo. — The Air Force Reserve Command's 302nd Airlift Wing flew multiple Modular Airborne Fire Fighting System missions today dropping fire retardant to draw lines of containment supporting the suppression efforts of the Spring Creek fire in Colorado.

The 302nd AW received a request for assistance from the National Interagency Fire Center for two MAFFS-equipped C-130 Hercules aircraft and aircrews to support fire suppression efforts in the Western U.S.

MAFFS is a self-contained aerial firefighting system, owned by the U.S. Department of Agriculture Forest Service, which can discharge 3,000 gallons of fire retardant in less than 10 seconds, covering an area one-quarter of a mile long by 100

feet wide. Once the load is discharged, it can be refilled in less than 12 minutes on the ground.

The Department of Defense, through U.S. Northern Command at Peterson AFB, provides unique military support to firefighting efforts when requested by the National Interagency Fire Center and approved by the Secretary of Defense. These diverse mission assets are prepared to respond quickly and effectively to protect lives, property, critical infrastructure and natural resources, and can include, but not limited to, MAFFS, military helicopters and ground forces capable of supporting the firefighting efforts.




