AETC command chief visits Little Rock AFB, discusses innovation

Chief Master Sgt. Julie Gudgel, command chief of Air Education and Training Command, toured the 314th Airlift Wing and met with AETC Airmen on July 23 at Little Rock Air Force Base.

Airmen of all ranks had the opportunity to listen, ask questions and discuss their ideas with Gudgel during her tour focusing on innovation in AETC.

The tour started in the Hercules Dining Facility where Gudgel was joined by Airmen to discuss new technologies being developed. She introduced new applications used on mobile devices so Airmen can have quick access to Air Force information at all times.

One app AETC is developing focuses around Airmen's careers. To help Airmen who may not be sure of their next step in their career path, the app will show each Air Force specialty code's career roadmap.

AETC also wants to make sure Airmen have everything they need for leveling up in their career fields. An app that will have the Airman's Handbook as well as other tools focused on career progress will be included along with interactive capabilities such as games, pretests and flashcards.

One benefit is Airmen don't have to pay for learning materials.

"We want to give you the tools to be successful as you progress in rank in your Air Force career," Gudgel said. "Airmen aren't always at a desktop, so we need to make sure that whatever we develop can work on any device."

After lunch at the Hercules DFAC, Gudgel proceeded to visit Airman Leadership School followed by an

all-call with the 314th AW senior noncommissioned officers. The SNCOs bounced ideas off one another through a discussion led by Gudgel about ways to improve the curriculum for students going through the 314th AW.

Lastly, Gudgel toured the 62nd Airlift Squadron's "Monster Garage." The garage is filled with C-130J equipment so students get hands-on learning for what they're going to be doing every day in a

controlled environment.

Throughout her visit, Gudgel emphasized the fact that AETC leadership isn't in the aircraft teaching students, so they need instructors' ideas on how to improve the curriculum and environment for students.

"At the end of the day, we aren't experts in your career fields," Gudgel said. "The only way we move forward in AETC is through your feedback."



Services gets the job done, ensures Airmen readiness

The Air National Guard is run by Airmen who are experts in many different jobs. Airmen take care of Airmen by providing medical, dental, financial and other services to ensure a ready force. While these jobs provide very specific amenities to our Air National Guardsmen, the backbone of any wing are the members of services.

“At some time in your military career we will serve you,” said Master Sgt. Ashley Brodnax, the 189th Services Operations noncommissioned officer in charge. “I feel it is a much-too-often thankless job. Many people don’t know what services does other than food, PT testing and lodging, but there is so much more!”

The 189th Services Flight recently supported the wing during Operation Sea Turtle, the bi-annual training event based at the Combat Readiness Training Center in Gulfport, Mississippi, ensuring more than 2,400 Airmen were provided food, lodging and other amenities while assigned to the center for the week. Throughout the week, 17 Services Airmen ensured the members of the 189th AW were cared for from sunrise to sunset.

“I think the most challenging part of the job during Gulfport was making sure we were getting supplies we ordered correct

so we would have enough food to serve everyone,” said Master Sgt. Jessica Sterlin, the 189th Services Flight Gulfport dining facility NCOIC. “It was hard, but we all learned a valuable lesson in that all of us do not train the same way and do the same thing but when the challenge comes, we can find a way to meet in the middle and get the job done.”

The 189th Services Flight also ensured morale and recreation were woven into the training period at Gulfport. During the last day of the training event, the wing participated in a sports day, allowing members of the wing to build bonds and strengthen ties within the unit. The event concluded with a word from Col. Crimmins, the 189th AW commander and Command Chief Master Sgt. Ron Boston, the 189th AW command chief, highlighting all the work the Airmen of the services flight accomplished visibly and behind the scenes.

Sterlin explained that the most rewarding part of her role during Gulfport was hearing someone tell one of her Airmen “thank you” or “great job” for the work that was accomplished while down at the training center. She also said that having leadership help serve food during meals was a great example for the services Airmen and showed them that no matter what rank you are, it is always a great thing

Col. Stephen Hodge assumed command of the 314th Airlift Wing from Col. Daniel DeVoe during a change of command ceremony officiated by Maj. Gen. Patrick Doherty, 19th Air Force commander, July 25 at Little Rock Air Force Base.

During his remarks, Doherty spoke about the importance of commanding at the wing level.

“Wing command is a special position,” Doherty said. “We in the Air Force talk about squadron command being the best job in the Air Force, but after doing it a few times I can tell you wing command is unique in its ways of making a difference for your Airmen, their families, veterans and the overall mission.”

Doherty also highlighted both DeVoe and Hodge’s many accomplishments and accolades throughout their careers.

“Col. DeVoe, you made our Air Force strong,” Doherty said. “Your efforts have been exceptional, and I wish you the best. To Col. Hodge, I want to thank you personally for what you’ve accomplished over the many years, to be so valued in the Air Force as an exceptional leader, to receive his second wing command at a critical moment in our Air Force’s history.”

Hodge received his commission from the United States Air Force Academy in 1993. Prior to his current assignment, Hodge was the 386th Air Expeditionary Wing commander in Southwest Asia. He has led missions during Operations Joint Endeavor, Southern Watch, Enduring Freedom and Iraqi Freedom.

After the official change of command, Hodge took a moment to comment on his upcoming role as the new 314th AW commander.

“I’m excited to be here,” Hodge said. “I appreciate the opportunity to be a part of this team at such a time and place in our nation and our history.”

Arkansas lowers tax rates, attract military families

Arkansas state law is set to change, allowing more tax benefits for service members, veterans and families of both.

Arkansas joins 28 states that provide full state tax exemptions to military retirees and family members of fallen service members; 19 others provide partial exemptions.

“When you’re looking at a 6.9-percent income tax rate, that’s a very significant benefit,” said Arkansas Gov. Asa Hutchinson. “[Military retirees] will come here to start a second career and will fall in love with the state. That is another incredible incentive.”

In 2013, Arkansas exempted active-duty pay from state taxation – giving active-duty Arkansans a reason to keep their state residency. The state also adopted an occupational licensure statute on behalf of members of the armed forces, veterans and military spouses.

Arkansas is a leader in a national effort to reform occupational licensure with an objective to identify and eliminate burdensome barriers to license portability across state lines.

“License reciprocity is a concern for many of our spouses,” said Col. Gerald Donohue, 19th Airlift Wing commander. “We don’t just bring Airmen into the Air Force - we bring families, and the onus is on us to make

sure we take care of them. Keeping an eye on this and other issues that are important to our families is one way of keeping up our end of the deal.”

A major focus of the effort has been to address challenges veterans and military families face.

In May, the governor’s office and the Arkansas Economic Development Commission awarded over \$700,000 to promote and facilitate a cyber program in local high schools.

In 2015, the state enacted the broadest higher education in-state tuition eligibility in the nation.

Through that initiative, all members of the armed forces, their spouses and veterans within three years of their discharge and their families are eligible for in-state tuition at Arkansas public higher education institutions – regardless of their official residence.

Combined, these initiatives secure state and community investments made in the education of service members before joining the military, strengthen readiness and recruiting, complement the Department of Defense’s education and training investment, and position the state to attract more military families to

discover or return to Arkansas.


