# When can I get my OCPs?

SCHRIEVER AIR FORCE BASE, Colo. – The official wear date for the operational camouflage pattern uniform was Oct. 1.

Some Airmen preparing to deploy, or who have deployed previously and those who have been assigned to Air Force Special Operations Command or Air Force Global Strike Command, may already have these uniforms. Others have already purchased OCPs to make sure they were ready the first week of October.

However, there is a caveat attached to the wear date.

James Mesco, historian with the 50th Space Wing, has been coordinating with the Air Force Space Command historian's office to clear official uniform patches.

Air Staff Manpower and Personnel, A1, is the authority in ensuring the process is executed.

"AFSPC needs a policy letter and/or a revised major command version of AFI 36-2903," Mesco said. "The historian's offices support the wing, groups and squadrons with the appropriate data on their specific emblem once we receive the OCP conversion information through the Institute of Heraldry and the Air Force Historical Research Agency."

In the conversion process, all Air Force heraldry will be examined to figure out the best way to convert the colors of the current emblems into a configuration meeting the OCP color scheme.

Once Headquarters Air Force Manpower and Personnel pays for the conversion, anticipated to be within fiscal year 2019 on or about Oct. 1, production will begin of the approved patches. This process alone could take a considerable

amount of time, according to Mesco.

"The conversion process at TIOH will take between six to nine months and the release will be all at once. HAF/A1 will not release them as TIOH completes the action," Mesco said. "For some units without heraldry or requiring updates, it may take a little longer."

Another challenge in the transition is the uniform itself, since OCPs have been part of the Air Force's inventory since 2012.

Master Sgt. Kathy Blake, superintendent with the 50th Comptroller Squadron, explained manufacturers cannot produce enough OCPs for every Airman to purchase right away.

"Even though they are authorized to wear Oct. 1, everyone has not been given the opportunity to own the OCP uniform," Blake said. "We are all excited for the change and have been given a long three year transition period."

Mesco cautioned purchasing accouterments and uniform sets until local guidance is issued.

"Until proper guidance is given, individuals could end up spending unit or personnel funds improperly," he said.

Mesco said the biggest thing to remember is wearing the new uniform Oct. 1 is an option, not a mandate. The wear of the uniform is not mandatory until April 1, 2021.

"Be patient," Blake said. "Approved wearing of the OCP is a step in the right direction in maintaining a single combat utility uniform, bringing back unit patches and most importantly it is giving the Airmen what they have been asking for."

**Patrol caps** will be worn with nametapes placed on the back using Velcro or sewn on. Officer rank will be sewn on the front of the hat and centered ½ inch above the visor.

**T-shirt** will be Tan.

**Name and USAF tape embroidery** will be spice brown thread.

**Right Sleeve** (max. 2 Velcro patches) Subdued U.S. Flags are mandatory and will be centered at the top of Velcro.

The following patches are approved to be worn under the US Flag:

Higher headquarters (HHQ) subdued cloth patch, Directorate subdued cloth patch, Inspector General identification subdued cloth patch, or subdued cloth patches/badges of awarded campaigns/combat while assigned to the awarding unit.

**Left Sleeve** (max. 2 Velcro patches) Organizational unit of assignment subdued cloth will be centered at the top of the Velcro area unless one of the following patches are worn:

Duty Identifier Tabs, or Joint qualification tabs may be worn, (e.g., Army Ranger, Sapper, Airborne, Air Commando, SERE, EOD) above the unit patch.

**Right or Left Sleeve** The following patches will be worn on either sleeve in place of either the HHQ or organizational unit patch:

Weapons Instructor Course patch (graduate or instructor), USAF Test Pilot School and School of Advanced Air patch, Space Studies patch, Critical Care Air Transport Team patch, Test Pilot School graduate patches or other completed equivalent schools

**Boots** will be Coyote Brown.

# Remembering Major General Self

Today, the flags at Little Rock Air Force Base will be flown at half-staff to mark the interment of Maj. Gen. Kip L. Self, a former commander of the 314th Airlift Wing. Self was the installation commander as a brigadier general from September 2005 through May 2007.

He took command at Little Rock AFB following Hurricane Katrina and continued the critical coordination and distribution of relief supplies involving numerous government agencies and international partners. As a focal point for domestic and international aid, Little Rock AFB's shift from flying training to operations supporting the relief under General Self was instrumental.

In honor of his passing, here are some of the milestones achieved during Self's tenure. He oversaw the construction and completion of numerous base facilities projects related to the new Lockheed C-130J Super Hercules formal training unit. Under the 48th Airlift Squadron, C-130 aircrew developed curriculum to train future combat airlifters in the operation of the newest model of the C-130 airframe. Under his command, the 48th AS stood up the school house and accepted the first international students for the J-model aircraft. On Dec. 21, 2005, he and Gen. William R. Looney, commander of Air Education and Training Command, flew the two

newest C-130Js to Little Rock AFB; both aircraft now belong to the 62nd Airlift Squadron and are still operating in the J-model training role. Self also oversaw the activation of the 714th Training Squadron that served as the administrative control of C-130 aircrew students. In his tenure as commander of the 314th AW, Self oversaw the training and graduation of over 5,000 combat airlifters. In preparation for the transfer of base host-unit responsibilities to what would become Air Mobility Command's 19th Airlift Wing, Self oversaw the transfer of over 30 seasoned E-models from the 314th AW to the boneyard at Davis Monthan AFB, Arizona. In the end, over 1,000 Airmen and 18 aircraft from the 314th AW were transitioned to the 19th AW on Oct. 1, 2008.

Self's career took him beyond Little Rock AFB, ending as the deputy chief of staff for operations, plans and requirements at Headquarters U.S. Air Force, Washington, D.C. Self retired on Jan. 1, 2011, marking over 32 years of active duty Air Force service. Today, we remember his commitment to Team Little Rock and to the Air Force.



# Team Little Rock prepares for air and space show with exercise

Team Little Rock tested the “prepare for the worst and expect the best” maxim during a major accident response exercise, or MARE, Oct. 2 ahead of the upcoming 2018 Thunder Over the Rock Air and Space Show.

The MARE, which is required prior to an air show, simulated a response to an aircraft accident to exercise agencies’ readiness and to ensure guest safety during the event.

“This MARE allows our off-base and on-base experts to test their skills and their response time as if we had an accident,” said Gregory Call, 19th Airlift Wing inspector general inspections plan designer. “We obviously don’t expect an aircraft accident, but we prepare for one.”

The main goal of holding a MARE is demonstrating the ability of Airmen and community partners to react to any unforeseen events while testing the command and control function of the installation to ensure proper communication between all appropriate agencies, media, base personnel and the surrounding community.

“Our Airmen are trained to the highest standard,” said Senior




