# Preventing suicide — starting with myself

F. E. WARREN AIR FORCE BASE, Wyo. — Other days, and even on good ones, the thought creeps up out of nowhere — an insidious sense of doubt, of worthlessness and a sense of purposelessness that whispers in my ear and tells me that I will never accomplish the goals I have set for myself. The thoughts that make me ask why I shouldn't just call it quits and end the sadness that plagues me.

I am just one of nearly a quarter of the population who has suffered with this illness for most of my life. Just like all of them, depression is present nearly every day of every year. If this sounds familiar to you, you are not alone. Millions in this country know the daily struggle of depression.

But I do not and I will not allow this disease to define me — and I ask anyone reading this who might be going through hard times to do the same. Maybe your situation is different. Maybe Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder haunts you and the things you've seen and experienced make you never want to open your eyes again. Maybe the stress of your job or your life seems to be too much to bear and you can't see any end in sight. Overwhelming anxiety. Brain injury. The effects of

substance abuse. So many different mental troubles can lead to suicidal ideation, which can complicate finding a solution for individuals thinking about hurting themselves.

Whatever personal challenge you're fighting with, please do everything you can to remind yourself that life is worth living. It's a challenge and often even a struggle, absolutely. But, no matter what you're struggling through, there are people who care about you with the resources available to help guide you through the darkness.

Whether it's an anonymous phone call to a hotline, a visit to a chaplain or a whole host of options in between, there are people — real people — out there who want to bring you back from the brink and help you realize that life is too precious to turn your back on. I have lost three people I considered friends — including one as close to me as a brother — to suicide. I will never forget the day I received the message that he died. It has stuck with me for 11 years now, a dull ache of loss for a friend torn away too soon. I ask myself if there was more I could have done to keep him from this end. He, and each of the others, left holes in those left behind when they died, and they are missed terribly by many people every day, even 11 years later.

For those of you who have made it this far and cannot relate to anything written above, I have a request for you, as well. Go to <https://www.af.mil/Suicide-Prevention/> and read about some of the programs and other resources available. If you see someone who's clearly not themselves, struggling with some unseen torture, ask them how they're doing. Ask them to get coffee or grab lunch. Sometimes all it takes to support someone in this situation is just being there. Or you can go a few steps further and learn the signs.

# Airmen use 5K to spread drug, domestic abuse awareness

Team Little Rock walked, ran and jogged on Oct. 5 to bring awareness to substance abuse and domestic violence.

October was designated Domestic Violence Awareness Month in 1987 to raise awareness and educate the public on prevention, and more recently in 2011, October also became National Substance Abuse Prevention Month.

The 19th Airlift Wing Drug Demand and Reduction program, 19th Medical Group Mental Health and 19th Medical Group Family Advocacy sponsored the run.

“These three agencies have teamed up because there are other areas that substance abuse affects,” said Sharise Holland, 19th Airlift Wing DDR program manager. “It can contribute to domestic violence, mental health disorders, sexual assaults and suicides. It’s all interconnected.”

Approximately 150 Airmen came out to spread awareness for the cause and combat adverse behaviors in their work places. Representatives from the base spoke before the event.

**Patrol caps** will be worn with nametapes placed on the back using Velcro or sewn on. Officer rank will be sewn on the front of the hat and centered 1/2 inch above the visor.

**T-shirt** will be Tan.

**Name and USAF tape** embroidery will be spice brown thread.

**Right Sleeve** (max. 2 Velcro patches) Subdued U.S. Flags are mandatory and will be centered at the top of Velcro.

The following patches are approved to be worn under the US Flag:

Higher headquarters (HHQ) subdued cloth patch, Directorate subdued cloth patch, Inspector General identification subdued cloth patch, or subdued cloth patches/badges of awarded campaigns/combat while assigned to the awarding unit.

**Boots** will be Coyote Brown.

**Left Sleeve** (max. 2 Velcro patches) Organizational unit of assignment subdued cloth will be centered at the top of the Velcro area unless one of the following patches are worn:

Duty Identifier Tabs, or Joint qualification tabs may be worn, (e.g., Army Ranger, Sapper, Airborne, Air Commando, SERE, EOD) above the unit patch.

**Right or Left Sleeve** The following patches will be worn on either sleeve in place of either the HHQ or organizational unit patch:

Weapons Instructor Course patch (graduate or instructor), USAF Test Pilot School and School of Advanced Air patch, Space Studies patch, Critical Care Air Transport Team patch, Test Pilot School graduate patches or other completed equivalent schools


Little Rock Air Force Base received various aircraft and personnel on Oct. 8-9 from Hurlburt Field, Fla., and Moody Air Force Base, Ga., ahead of the projected landfall of Hurricane Michael.

AC-130J Ghostriders, AC-130U Spooky gunships, MC-130H Combat Talon IIs, and A-10 Thunderbolt IIs are bedding down at Little Rock AFB until the potential for bad weather ends.

The aircraft relocated as a precaution to the the expected landfall of Hurricane Michael along the Florida Panhandle and East Coast.

The relocation to Little Rock AFB ensures aircraft and aircrews from those installations are out of harm's way until they can safely return to their home station.

"While this move is precautionary, our doors are always open to ensure Airmen and Air Force assets remain safe during inclement weather such as this," said Col. Gerald Donohue, 19th Airlift Wing commander.




