# 223rd COS graduates first in-residence mission defense team

The 223rd Cyberspace Operations Squadron held a graduation ceremony Friday, Sept. 6 at Little Rock Air Force Base for 20 cyber defenders assigned to mission defense teams across the Air Force to include active duty and reservists. The ceremony was attended by leadership from Air Combat Command and the Arkansas National Guard. The graduates were the first from the only in-residence initial qualification training course currently provided to MDT operators nationwide.

According to Capt. Scott Lang, the 223rd COS Chief of Programs and Policies, Air Force active duty, National Guard and Reserve units plan to push more than 300 students through the MDT course throughout fiscal year 2020, raising in-residence initial qualification trained operators from 4 to 58 percent Air Force-wide. Lang also explained further investments put into the squadron and other cyber units across the Air Force will grow pipeline student training to more than 500 annually in

the 223rd COS and more than 1,000 initial qualification students annually across the Air Force.

“The mission defense teams are an Air Force construct designed to provide wing commanders, cyber-based mission assurance and defense across the assigned weapon system for that wing,” said Lt. Col. Eroica Waggoner, the 223rd

COS deputy. “It’s a novel concept within the Air Force. It takes communications Airmen that have been historically focused on service-providing roles and placing them into a role where they need an operational mindset.”

The Air Force is currently the only Department of Defense component that trains mission defense teams. The

graduation is one step in the total force initiative to provide training for weapons systems support. Currently, the training for cyber protection operators and mission defense teams is being provided at the 39th Intelligence Operations Squadron but not in an initial qualification training atmosphere. The students who attended this initial course had zero MDT training before arriving at the 189th Airlift Wing.

The MDT concept is not specific to DOD weapons systems. Within the state of Arkansas, there are many cyber elements that should be looked at and assessed. Every year, more and more incidents are occurring within the United States and National Guard cyber operators are being called in to analyze the systems and train others to better defend their cyber domains.

“We could build an MDT with our DSG’s using the same construct as the Air Force to respond to an incident that could happen domestically,” Waggoner said. “It’s the same team principle. We’re simply applying it to a domestic scenario instead of federal.”

This resulted in 13 grounded aircraft being returned to service within 24 hours with no negative impact to flying operations.

For service members it's important to ensure personal property, finances and loved ones are taken care of at all times. The 19th Airlift Wing Judge Advocate Office provides free legal assistance locally for Airmen at Little Rock Air Force Base.

"A lot of people just associate us with punishing people, and that's not all we're here for," said U.S. Air Force Staff Sgt. Joyce Bray, NCO in charge of adverse actions.

Visiting Team Little Rock's legal office is one of the key components of ensuring combat readiness by maintaining one's legal affairs.

"Airmen should be legally ready all the time, not just when tasked with deployment," said U.S. Air Force Major Ryan Richter, 19th AW deputy staff judge advocate. "Don't wait until you're 15 days out to get on a plane to go to the Middle East."

It is still highly recommended by the legal office for Airmen about to deploy to



## GENERATION TO GENERATION Carrying on C-130 legacy

Every box is checked and the crew is ready to go. The familiar hum of a C-130J engine begins to fill the cockpit as the plane slowly creeps forward, inch by inch. They reach the runway, and the plane's props begin to spin vigorously as it darts forward. Within a few moments, the Herk is gliding gracefully through the air.

U.S. Air Force Capt. John Rebolledo, 62nd Airlift Squadron C-130J instructor pilot, feels great pride in achieving his childhood dream of becoming a C-130 pilot.

Rebolledo knew he wanted to be behind the controls of a C-130 from a young age. He grew up around the rich history and traditions of Herk Nation.

"My dad was a C-130A-model crew chief in Vietnam, so I grew up hearing all the stories about tactical airlift and about how great the C-130 was – and still is today," Rebolledo said. "Once I decided I wanted to be a pilot, I knew I wanted to fly a Herk."

After graduating high school, Rebolledo attended the Air Force Academy for four years in hopes of achieving his dream of flying. Upon graduation from the academy, Rebolledo was given a pilot training allocation where he would finally achieve his dream of flying. This came with a few obstacles, including getting air sick during the first half of the course.

"This was the first time I thought I might not end up being a pilot," Rebolledo said. "Eventually, a lot of perseverance and discipline with getting back in the pilot's seat and flying over and over helped me overcome it."

The young pilot was now on his way to make his dream a reality. He received orders to fly the C-130H at Yokota Air Base, Japan, for three years and then transitioned to the C-130J.

"The mission is very rewarding," Rebolledo said. "We go into places that have been struck by natural disasters. The people there are extremely desperate

because their lives have just been upended, so we bring in things to aid them like food, vaccines and clothing. When you are doing a job like that it's pretty easy to take pride in your job."

Rebolledo proved himself to be a skilled pilot and was given the critical task of teaching the next generation of Herk pilots.

"We are teaching those who have never touched the plane before," said U.S. Air Force Maj. Chance Hansen, 62nd AS assistant director of operations and Rebolledo's supervisor. "When you are teaching someone at that skill level, it takes a lot of extra work, and you really have to be on your game to be able to fly and be safe."

Rebolledo takes gratification in being given the opportunity to communicate his knowledge and love of the C-130 to his successors.

"Now, I take a lot of pride in being an instructor because I get to take my humanitarian aid and wartime experiences and translate that into something meaningful for these students who are coming through," Rebolledo said.

Being able to accept that he won't always have the right answer drives Rebolledo to find the proper

solution to the problems at hand.

"It takes a lot of humility," Rebolledo said. "To me that means recognizing that you don't know everything and having a humble spirit. It's important to always want to learn lessons from pilots who are older or younger than you."

Rebolledo's reputation as a pilot and an instructor has garnered himself attention from his current leaders.

"He always had a very positive reputation as a pilot," Hansen said. "He cares about what he does and shows up every day trying to be a better pilot than he was yesterday and is an excellent addition to the squadron."


In the end, Rebolledo pursued the C-130 legacy and used his heritage as motivation in order to make his dreams become a reality.

"I'm immensely grateful and very satisfied with what I do," Rebolledo said. "Being a C-130 pilot had been my dream from a young age so being able to self-actualize and obtain my dream is so deeply rewarding. I also gain a lot of satisfaction in imparting my love for this airplane and this mission to the new generation that is going to be flying and performing the tactical airlift mission."

come see them before they leave.

“We can help you set up your affairs before you leave to help alleviate stress,” Bray said. “With a power of attorney it will help so you don’t have to worry about what happens – even something small such as when your spouse is at home and loses an ID card.”

The office frequently handles wills and powers of attorney, however they are also equipped to help with a variety of issues with which members may need guidance.

“We have legal assistance appointments for Airmen who maybe just want to talk to an attorney,” Richter said. “We can help with family law issues, difficulty with landlords, an issue with a car or anything that there could be a legal issue with and they just need some advice. If we can’t help, we can give them resources. Coming to see us is a way to figure out where to start.”

While helping Airmen is a significant part of what they do, the office knows the importance of upholding standards set by the Air Force.

“The law touches everything we do as an Air Force,” Richter said. “Assisting commanders with things such as disciplinary administrative actions helps keep us a disciplined force, and a disciplined force is a more effective fighting force. We can’t have criminality if we’re going to accomplish the mission.”

According to Bray, the legal team makes the effort to let all the newcomers know what they offer.

“Our main job is to help everyone who walks through our door,” Bray said. “Whether it’s to point you in the right direction or to let you leave with the correct document, we’ll answer your questions the best we can.”

The Judge Advocate office is located in building 1250. Walk-in times for legal assistance are Mondays from 2-3 p.m. and Wednesdays from 9-11 a.m. To make an appointment, call 501-987-7886.
