

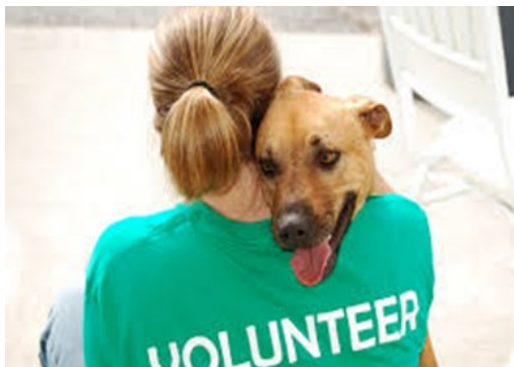
About the LRAFB Volunteer Program
