The career focus programs are continually reviewed and updated to provide our service members and their families with the most up to date information and skills to be successful in their career search and skills development. We welcome any concerns or questions in regards to the course material.

Federal Resume Workshop – 1st Tuesday of each month:

This workshop introduces the attendees to USAJOBs. First hour we cover the in's and out's of USAJOBs and how it works, what to look for. The second hour we go over how to breakdown a federal job announcement and how to formulate a bullet statement to give you the best opportunity for success. Lastly we cover the New Hiring Assessments which became mandatory for new federal hires 16 August of 2018. Call 987-2667 to schedule for the class.

Private Resume Workshop - 2nd Tuesday of each month:

We provide two hours of guidance to create a chronological or functional formatted resume. This course was developed from established resume guidelines and inputs from federal, state, and local Human Resource Managers and Recruiters on their do's and don'ts for an effective resume. We also cover bullet statement writing and go over one in class. Call 987-2667 to schedule for the class.

Job Search in Arkansas – 3rd Tuesday of each month:

This class is designed to assist attendees in seeing the job market in a defined way that works best for them. Most job seekers get overwhelmed and we provide that guidance to make it easier to see what is available, how to apply for it, where those potential careers are. It is a 30 minute brief with 1 hour and half hour internet interaction. Call 987-2667 to schedule for the class.

The following classes are on alternate 4th or 5th Tuesdays of the month: LinkedIn or LeftOut:

A two hour class going over how to setup a LinkedIn account, how to establish branding for the account, great do's and don'ts, options and use for your profile. Call 987-2667 to schedule the class.

Spouse Employment Programs:

A two hour class that covers the two prime DoD programs for military spouses, the Military Spouse Employment Program (MSEP) and the Spouse Education & Career Opportunities (SECO).
