- REPRESENTS YOU AND YOU ALONE
- PROVIDES **CONFIDENTIAL** LEGAL ADVICE
- PROTECTS YOUR RIGHTS & PRIVACY INTERESTS
- PROVIDES LEGAL ASSISTANCE
- ADVISES YOU ON THE INVESTIGATION & PROSECUTION PROCESSES
- ATTENDS INTERVIEWS WITH YOU
- ATTENDS HEARINGS & COURTS-MARTIAL WITH YOU

• WHO DOES THE SVC WORK FOR? You!

- SVC **DOES NOT** WORK FOR ANYONE ON YOUR BASE
- CHAIN OF COMMAND IS AN INDEPENDENT OFFICE IN DC

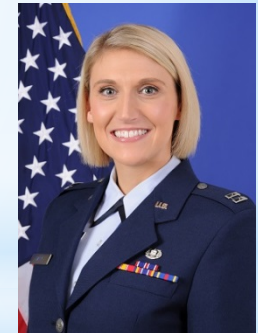

Remember! To maintain a choice for a restricted report, you must go to an SVC, the SARC, anywhere in the MDG, or a Chaplain.

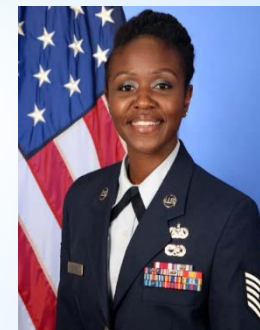
