19th Airlift Wing Office of the Staff Judge Advocate (19 AW/JA)

Courts-Martial

An Airman First Class assigned to the 19th Maintenance Squadron was found guilty of one violation of Article 112A – Wrongful use of cocaine, a schedule II controlled substance, and received a reduction to Airman Basic and two months confinement.

Article 15 Actions (Non-Judicial Punishment)

A Master Sergeant assigned to the 19th Aircraft Maintenance Squadron received a forfeiture of \$2,283 for two months and a reprimand for one violation of Article 128 – Assault Consummated by a battery.

A Senior Airman assigned to the 19th Aircraft Maintenance Squadron received a reduction to Airman First Class and a reprimand for one violation of Article 92 – Willful dereliction of duty, for willfully misusing his GTC.

A Staff Sergeant assigned to the 19th Civil Engineer Squadron received a reduction to Senior Airman, 7 days extra duty, and a reprimand for one violation of Article 93 – Cruelty/Maltreatment.

An Airman First Class assigned to the 19th Logistics Readiness Squadron received a reduction to Airman and a reprimand for one violation of Article 111 – Drunken driving.

An Airman First Class assigned to the 19th Logistics Readiness Squadron received a reduction to Airman, restriction for 30 days, and a reprimand for one violation of Article 112a – Wrongful use of marijuana.

An Airman assigned to the 19th Logistics Readiness Squadron received a suspended reduction to Airman Basic and a reprimand for one violation of Article 92 – Willful dereliction of duty for willfully consuming alcohol while underage.

Involuntary Discharges

An Airman was discharged with an Honorable service characterization for failing to progress in military training.

An Airman was discharged with an Honorable service characterization for failing to meet minimum fitness standards.

An Airman was discharged with a General service characterization for drug abuse.
