#### **Courts-Martial**

#### **Article 15 Actions (Non-Judicial Punishment)**

A Master Sergeant assigned to the 19th Maintenance Group received a reduction to Technical Sergeant suspended and a suspended forfeiture of \$2,338 for violation of Article 112a – Wrongful use of a schedule V controlled substance (Codeine).

A Senior Airman assigned to the 19th Aircraft Maintenance Squadron received a reduction to Airman First Class suspended, a suspended forfeiture of \$506, and 14 days extra duty for violation of Article 86 – Failure to go.

A Senior Airman assigned to the 19th Maintenance Squadron received a reduction to Airman First Class, a suspended forfeiture of \$1,088 a month for two months, and 14 days extra duty for violation of Article 128 – Assault consummated by a battery.

A Senior Airman assigned to the 19th Maintenance Squadron received a reduction to Airman First Class, a suspended forfeiture of \$1,088 a month for two months, and 14 days of extra duty for violation of Article 111 – Drunken Driving.

A Senior Airman assigned to the 19th Civil Engineer Squadron received a reduction to Airman First Class and 30 days of extra duty suspended for violation of Article 92 – Dereliction of Duty (Sleeping while on Duty).

An Airman First Class assigned to the 19th Aircraft Maintenance Squadron received a reduction to Airman and a suspended forfeiture of \$918 a month for 2 months for violation of Article 132 – False writing in connection with a claim.

An Airman First Class assigned to the 19th Aircraft Maintenance Squadron received a reduction to Airman and a forfeiture of \$428 for violation of Article 112a – Wrongful use of Marijuana.
