Courts-Martial

An Airman First Class assigned to the 19th Aerospace Medicine Squadron was found guilty of providing alcohol to a minor and wrongful distribution of a Schedule II controlled substance in violation of Articles 92 and 112a, UCMJ. The member was sentenced to 15 days confinement, hard labor without confinement for 15 days, forfeiture of \$1,320.00 pay and reduction to E-1.

Article 15 Actions (Non-Judicial Punishment)

A Lieutenant Colonel received forfeitures of \$4,499.00 pay for two months and a reprimand for assault consummated by battery and conduct unbecoming an officer in violation of Articles 128 and 133, UCMJ.

A Second Lieutenant received forfeitures of \$1,594.00 pay for two months and a reprimand for two failures to obey a general order and fraternization in violation of Articles 92 and 134, UCMJ.

A Senior Master Sergeant received a suspended reduction to Master Sergeant, forfeiture of \$1,500.00 pay for two months and a reprimand for willful dereliction of duty in violation of Article 92, UCMJ.

A Staff Sergeant assigned to the 19th Civil Engineer Squadron received a suspended reduction to Senior Airman, forfeiture of \$1,332.00 pay and a reprimand for being drunk on duty and driving while intoxicated in violation of Articles 112, and 113, UCMJ.

A Senior Airman assigned to the 19th Aircraft Maintenance Squadron received a reduction to Airman First Class and a reprimand for wrongful use of marijuana in violation of Article 112a, UCMJ.

A Senior Airman assigned to the 19th Aircraft Maintenance Squadron received a suspended reduction to Airman First Class and forfeiture of \$202.00 pay for failure to go in violation of Article 86, UCMJ.

An Airman First Class assigned to the 41st Airlift Squadron received a suspended reduction to Airman and a reprimand for underage drinking in violation of Article 92, UCMJ.
