#### **Courts-Martial**

#### **Article 15 Actions (Non-Judicial Punishment)**

A Senior Airman received a reduction to Airman First Class, suspended forfeitures of \$1,116.00 for 2 months, and a reprimand for larceny of non-military property less than \$1000 in violation of Article 121 of the UCMJ.

A Staff Sergeant received 30 days extra duty, forfeitures of \$400.00 for 2 months and a reprimand for assault consummated by batter in violation of Article 128 of the UCMJ.

An Airman First Class received a suspended reduction Airman for willful dereliction of duty in violation of Article 92 of the UCMJ.

A Senior Airman received a suspended reduction to Airman First Class and a reprimand for disorderly conduct in violation of Article 134 of the UCMJ.

An Airman First Class received a reduction to Airman Basic, 15 days extra duty, a reprimand, and suspended forfeiture of \$250.00 for 2 months for willful dereliction of duty in violation of Article 92 and for larceny of non-military property less than \$1000 in violation of Article 121 of the UCMJ.

An Airman First Class received forfeitures of \$942.00 pay and a reprimand for make or alter a military pass or ID in violation of Article 105 of the UCMJ.

#### **Involuntary Discharges**

An Airman First Class was discharged with a General service characterization for minor disciplinary infractions.

An Airman Basic was discharged with a General service characterization for drug abuse and minor disciplinary infractions.

An Airman First Class was discharged with a General service characterization for minor disciplinary infractions.

An Airman First Class was discharged with a General service characterization for a pattern of misconduct prejudicial to good order and discipline.

A Lt Colonel was discharged with a General service characterization for a serious or recurring misconduct punishable by military or civilian authorities.

A Senior Airman was discharged with an Honorable service characterization for conditions that interfere with military service.

An Airman First Class was discharged with an Honorable service characterization for failure to meet minimum fitness standards.
