

Home Based Primary Care (HBPC) provides primary health care to eligible Veteran patients in their homes when care in the outpatient clinics is not possible or recommended. HBPC is like a clinic visit at your home.

HBPC is a team of health care professionals who will teach you and your caregiver about your medical problems (medications and how to take them, what food to eat, a safe exercise program, and more); and provide guidance to make your care easier and safer.

To be eligible for HBPC you must be homebound, have a caregiver in the home, and live in the HBPC service area.

HBPC serves Veterans in Pulaski, Faulkner, Saline and Garland counties. In addition, HBPC serves Veterans who live in the following towns and cities: Cabot, Ward, Austin, Beebe, Pine Bluff, Redfield, Sheridan, East End, and Malvern.

Talk to your primary care provider to find out if you are eligible for HBPC services.

HBPC does not provide:

- * emergency services
- * daily nursing care
- * daily therapy
- * housekeeping or chore services
