The Central Arkansas Veterans Healthcare System (CAVHS) consists of two inpatient campuses located at Little Rock (196 Beds) and North Little Rock 651 Beds), Arkansas. CAVHS has eight Community-Based Outpatient Clinics (CBOCs) in Conway, Hot Springs, El Dorado, Mountain Home, Mena, Pine Bluff, Russellville and Searcy, Arkansas. These eight clinics serve Veterans living in the northern, western, and central counties of Arkansas, as well as border counties in surrounding states. The Veterans Day Treatment Center moved into a newly remodeled downtown Little Rock facility in March 2013, consolidating three separate operating locations and serving Veterans across the region, many of whom are without homes. The Home Health Care Service Center is based in West Lake Industrial Center in Littler Rock with a satellite branch in Hot Springs. Our CDCE office of Operations is located at 2200 Fort Roots Drive North Little Rock North We also support Vet Center in Little Rock with Volunteers and donations. Arkansas State Veterans Home is on the North Little Rock campus, and we have an MOU that supports Volunteers and Donations to 96 Veterans cared for in the Home. We have 150 Bed Community Living Center and 167 Mental Health and Domiciliary beds at North Little Rock. We also support off site VA Contracted Veterans without Home Beds in Little Rock and NLR.

We have a Comprehensive Adult Day Health Care, Mental Health Intensive Case Management and Care Giver Support Programs at North Little Rock. Our Home-Based Primary Care supports 175 Central Arkansas and Hot Springs Community Veterans.

CAVHS is a tertiary care facility classified as a Level 1b on the VA Complexity Model. It is a teaching hospital that provides a full range of patient care services, with state-of-the-art technology. In addition to education, CAVHS is active in research. Comprehensive healthcare is provided through primary, tertiary, and long-term care in areas of medicine, surgery, mental health, physical medicine and rehabilitation, neurology, dentistry, ophthalmology, geriatrics and extended care, and women's health. CAVHS is part of the South-Central VA Health Care Network (VISN 16), which includes facilities in Arkansas, Florida, Louisiana, Mississippi, Oklahoma, and Texas. The overall function and purpose of the Voluntary Service is to provide volunteers to perform many duties necessary to support the overall purpose, function, and mission of the medical center; that is to provide high quality healthcare to our

nation's Veterans in Central Arkansas and surrounding areas of Arkansas. In order to support the needs of Veterans we provide volunteers and accept donations for the medical facility. Voluntary Service is also responsible for managing General Post Funds (GPF) donations, recruiting and managing volunteers, and working closing with management officials in identifying diverse opportunities where volunteers can provide valuable services to our nation's Veterans. Often times it's as simple as a visit by an individual or organization.
