

US AIR FORCE SPECIAL VICTIMS' COUNSEL (SVC)

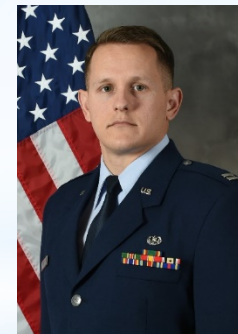

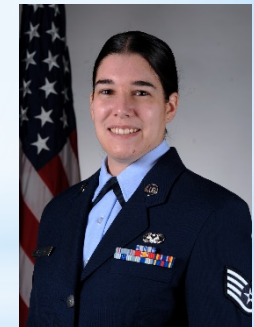
