



CDC/SAC Summer Camp



- 30 High risk staff will all return to work to meet the needs of the base
- All buildings will re-open; normal hours 0630-1800
 - CDC's return 25 high risk – capacity 260 children, 214 enrolled / 46 spaces available – 79 on priority 1 waiting list
 - SAC return 5 high risk- capacity 48 children; 34 enrolled / 14 spaces available - 22 on priority 1 waiting list
- Limited services:
 - Will accept new enrollments based on space/wait list
 - May consider not accepting high risk children per HAF guidance
 - Will not provide service to teleworking personnel (unless directed by Wing and AFSVC)
 - Those not using care will not be charged or lose their spot (unless directed by AFSVC)

Mitigation

- Minimize staff & children – no teleworking personnel
- Minimize mixing - Staff & children remain in same rooms as much as possible
- Facemasks will be worn by all staff, custodians, visitors, parents if 6ft distance can't be maintained
- Will minimize number of children in large group gatherings such as, outdoor play, early and late afternoon transitions, school age activity rooms, and school age mealtimes
- Will try to avoid combining classrooms at the beginning and ending of each day
- Sanitization Process
 - Step 1: Prior to opening/throughout day disinfect counter tops, cubbies, doors/cabinet handles, panic hardware, toilets, faucets, sinks, playground equipment, and materials used by parents signing in/out
 - Step 2: Wear disposable clothes, clean surfaces w/soap/water.
 - Step 3: Spray surfaces w/bleach solution (1/3 cup bleach per gallon water) & let sit for 1 minute
 - Step 4: Consider modifying custodial contract; increase frequency of cleaning of common areas
