Drive Excellence - The Black Knights have a reputation of excellence. The future of Little Rock Air Force Base remains on our shoulders.

LOE 1: Align our battle rhythm, training priorities, and processes to optimize AFFORGEN.

LOE 2: Expand our Warrior Airmen Readiness (WAR) Center capabilities, develop 200-level training, and master our crafts.

LOE 3: Prioritize our Airmen and their families as we define our rear-echelon requirements.

Project Power - All echelons must be ready, at home and away. Mission-capable supporting forces are critical to our readiness, TacAir Anywhere and our power projection platform.

LOE 1: Present a 27.1- ready wing construct and CABS NLT the 2026 CRI.

LOE 2: Improve, sustain, and defend our infrastructure and in-garrison personnel.

LOE 3: Ready our C-130J fleet for worldwide combat airlift requirements.

Lead - HAF and AMC have made it clear. The Black Knights are out front.

LOE 1: Build, test and validate the Air Force's model to employ forces in combat.

LOE 2: Create and execute a wing training plan that can be replicated across the Air Force.

LOE 3: Enhance the Black Knights family to foster connectedness, culture, and cooperation within all our communities.
