


KEEP A CLEAN MACHINE

- KEEP SECURITY SOFTWARE CURRENT: Keep antivirus, firewall, antispyware up-to-date
- AUTOMATE SOFTWARE UPDATES: Configure the operating system to automatic updates
- ■PROTECT ALL DEVICES THAT CONNECT TO THE INTERNET: Protect phones, tablets, kindles, and game boxes
- PLUG & SCAN: Always scan any data storage medium, such as USBs and other external devices before using

- Use Tools (password-manager service) To Manage Passwords




CONNECT WITH CARE
